

Over The Hill to Jerome, Page Springs, the Village of Oak Creek and Sedona

The ride includes 158 "twisties" in a 12 mile stretch over the Mingus into Jerome. The curves present no surprises but do be careful and pay attention to the recommended speed postings around the curves. The rock walls on one side and the guardrails (where they exist) will usually keep you in play. From Jerome, the ride continues through Cottonwood toward Sedona. A turn onto Page Springs Rd will take you past The Page Springs Fish Hatchery, open to the public as well as several wineries open for tasting and tours. Onward you go onto Cornville and Beaverhead Flat Rd to SR179 and north through the Village of Oak Creek, Red Rock Country and into Sedona. At any point along the way the scenery is varied and marvelous. There are a number of side roads worth considering to places like The Chapel of The Holy Cross in Sedona. There are many restaurants and services along the way. There are also about 16 combined roundabout traffic circles between Cottonwood, Oak Creek Village and Sedona. Watch out for tourists! Cell phone coverage is good.
