

Ride to the Grand Canyon

Take a scenic ride to the Grand Canyon with a breakfast stop at the Pine Country Inn in historic Williams, AZ along I-40 (Rte66) and continue on to the Grand Canyon. Plan your ride carefully. Much time...days...can be spent in the Park itself, the Visitor Center and riding to/from the various scenic overlooks. You can ride your bikes into the Park, to the Village, Visitor Center, The El Tovar hotel area and back east along the Desert View Rd (SR64) to the East Gate. The west road from the Village area can be accessed only by riding the trams but there is plenty of parking. There is a restaurant and gas station at the East Gate.
